

Poipu Golf Info:

There are many golf courses near by including one of the most famous, Poipu Bay <http://www.poipubaygolf.com/>
The hidden (in plain view) perk at Poipu Bay is the \$15 driving range/putting green/ chipping area - which you get unlimited balls and can play all day for the one price! Also they have twilight prices for golf after 2:00 at a reduced rate.

Kiahuna Golf course is also right in Poipu and is a Robert Trent designed course with some interesting history. Ask about the spider found only on Kauai! <http://www.kiahunagolf.com/>

In addition there is a very reasonable public course with amazing views:
